Notes

1. The Harescombe Charity of Miles Huntley can provide grants for educational/training purposes to persons under the age of 25 years, who live in the parish of Harescombe
2. Proof of residence may be requested by the trustees.
3. Examples of possible qualifying purposes for grants include computers required for study purposes, books and training courses.
4. Applications for school fees will normally only be considered in the event of unexpected financial hardship
5. Young persons living away at university or college may apply for a grant if they live in Harescombe during their holidays
6. Although every effort will be made to provide grants to all qualifying applications, a preference will be given to cases of financial hardship, and where the applicant/child has lived in the village for at least 3 years.
7. Grants are made purely at the discretion of the trustees and their decision is final
8. Every effort will be made by the trustees to consider applications within 21 days of receipt
